

**How to use Talk it Over:**

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your family / friends turn what God is saying to you into action steps.

**Pastor Tim's Main Idea:**

Jesus is teaching us that it is only when we fully realize our thirst that we can be quenched with eternal life.

**Key Questions:**

- What's one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this idea grab your attention?
- Why did Jesus stop and speak with the woman? Does it matter that she was a Samaritan woman?
- Why does Jesus use thirsting for water as a metaphor for eternal life?
- Why do you think Jesus brought up the subject of her past?
- Despite her past, her future was forever changed. What hope does this provide us?

**Next Steps**

- What's one thing you will do this week as a result of something you learned from this message?
- If your attempts to quench your thirst have failed, choose to receive Jesus, the Living Water.
